

AIS. Serhii Zinchenko was the president for the summer semester 2017/2018, then for the summer semester 2019/2020 this role was taken over by Ms Anastasiia Tsvirkun, and currently the role of AIS President is performed by Ms Iryna Yablonska (iryna.yablonska@student.wsg.byd.pl). The members of the association cooperate with the Student Self-Government of the University of Gdańsk, organize events for children (also for children coming to Poland from Ukraine), competitions, cabarets, and theater trips and operas, help first-year students to acclimatize at the University. AIS students actively participated in several editions of the Bydgoszcz Science Festival they performed by dancing and singing for audiences outside the University, also abroad. Several times in this area of the University they organized student events, which integrated very large groups of students, under the name of "What can you", during which the talents of WSG students were presented. They co-organized the Student's Ball 2018 at the Hotel Pod Orłem and the Student's Ball 2019 at the Kuźnia Hotel with the Student Government and the Academic Sports Association of WSG. During the ball, people who are most involved in the student life at the university are awarded. The ball has already had four editions and its prestige and interest are growing year by year. Unfortunately, the Student's Ball 2020 did not take place due to the prevailing epidemic. AIS students participated in a trip to Kiev at the forum "Ukraine and the world - dialogue through youth", they completed an internship at the Supreme Council of Ukraine Every year the association conducts meetings with students from Ukraine "Presentation of AIS activities, perspectives and opportunities for students of WSG", implemented the projects "Children are asking for peace", Peace in Ukraine and around the world, aid directed to Ukraine for the most needy children and soldiers. AIS representative took part in the Congress of the Students' Parliament of the Republic of Poland. As part of the Association, the English Team, which associates English-speaking students of WSG, began its activity in the summer semester 2018/2019. AIS, together with the English Team, is planning a series of integration events and is actively involved in preparations for the next Student's Ball. In the 2020/2021 academic year, AIS organized a series of student meetings in the Teams app. At the beginning of the new calendar year, AIS members have planned the implementation of the following events: "A student who proudly wants to identify with the university" (20/01/2021), "How to become a valuable employee after graduation" (02/02/2021).
